

### **Clergy Corner**



As we continue enjoying the peace and joy of Easter, we celebrate today the Feast of Divine Mercy. We have a nice picture of Divine Mercy in our church. Sister Faustina had a vision of Divine Mercy in 1931 in Poland. An artist, Eugene painted it in 1934. In 2000, Pope John Paul II dedicated

the Feast of Divine Mercy on the second Sunday of Easter.

The image has many symbols. Dark background

of the image means the world is in darkness without Jesus. Jesus is the Light that dispels the darkness, showing us the way. Five wounds seen on the Lord's hands, symbol of the Risen Christ. Right hand raised is in the act of blessing us.



Left hand is showing the opening to his heart to us. The white ray signifies the water that poured forth from Christ's side indicating the cleansing. The red

ray signifies the blood that poured from the side of Christ indicates the power of the Most Holy Eucharist.

White robe represents the priesthood. Eyes looking downward means Jesus' suffering and dying. He continues to look upon us with the same love and mercy. Left foot stepping forward means Jesus makes the first move, coming to us with his peace. The inscription 'Jesus I Trust in You' is a reminder of the need to trust in God's mercy. Therefore, dear friends let us become the messengers of Divine Mercy.


