### **Clergy Corner**

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Finally we have reached the long awaited milestone of our parish: the 75th Anniversary of the dedication of our church building and the 91st Annual Parish Festival! Bishop Soto's presence as the main celebrant of this Mass will be an added bonus to the event. During this

Mass he will install me as the new pastor of our parish. I am looking forward to your esteemed presence, prayers and support. Let us also gratefully remember all of our former Pastors and priests who have served our St. Mary's parish.

I also have an exciting update on Fr. Mathai's visa. The U.S. Immigration Department has approved his papers and as soon as he gets the hard copy of it, he will join us here at St. Mary's.

The readings of this weekend speak of the expansive and universal nature of the "Kingdom of God," in contrast with the theory that salvation was to be offered first to the Jews and then, through them alone, to the rest of the world.

In the First Reading, God reveals the truth that in His eyes there is no distinction among human beings on the basis of race, caste, or color. The long-expected Messianic Kingdom was intended not only for the Jews but for all nations.

In the Second Reading, Paul explains that, although the Jews were the chosen people, many of them rejected Jesus as the promised Messiah, and, consequently, God turned to the gentiles who received mercy through their faith in Jesus.

In the Gospel story, Jesus demonstrates that salvation was meant for the Gentiles as well as for the Jews by healing the daughter of a Gentile woman as a reward for her strong faith. Thus, Jesus shows us that God's mercy and love are available to all who call out to Him in faith.


