



# **Clergy Corner**

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



This Sunday's readings invite us to a way of life marked by humility and generosity. Sirach reminds us that "the greater you are, the more you must humble yourself," and Jesus in the Gospel calls us to take the lower place at the banquet and to invite those who cannot repay us—

the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. True greatness in God's eyes is found not in power or prestige, but in service and compassion.

This week we also celebrate Labor Day, a time to thank God for the dignity of human work and for all workers who, through their labor, build families, strengthen communities, and contribute to the common good. Work is not only about wages but also about vocation—sharing in God's ongoing creation and serving others with our gifts.

On September 5th, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Teresa of Calcutta. Her life beautifully echoes today's Gospel. She humbled herself by serving "the least of these" with joy and simplicity. She reminded us that "not all of us can do great things, but we can do small things with great love." Like her, we are called to see Christ in the hungry, the lonely, the forgotten, and to extend love without expecting anything in return.

As we mark Labor Day and honor St. Teresa, let us ask for the grace to live our work and daily lives with humility, to uplift those around us, and to welcome all-especially those who cannot repay us—into the banquet of God's love.


