

## **Clergy Corner**

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Thank God that our church, rectory and office were not damaged, and that no one was injured when the giant Redwood fell in last Sunday's windstorm. I believe that Our Blessed Virgin Mary interceded to protect us. Both Fr. Mathai and I were inside the rectory when it happened.

Our church step project is in progress.

Pope Saint John Paul II designated February 11 as World Day of the Sick, "a special time of prayer and sharing of offering one's suffering for the good of the Church and of reminding us to see in our sick brothers and sisters the face of Christ who, by suffering, dying and rising, achieved the salvation of humankind."

World Marriage Day is also celebrated this Sunday.

Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. This year Ash Wednesday falls on 14th February (Valentine's Day).

The annual Lenten season is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter! The Lenten season has a double character, namely to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the Paschal mystery. The catechumens, both the rite of election and scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian Initiation, the faithful ever more attentive to the word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises." Lenten weekdays are not commemorated on Solemnities and Feasts. Also 'Alleluia' is not sung or said from the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil. Just remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of universal fast and abstinence in the Church.
