



Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



This weekend, we celebrate the beautiful Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, a moment rich with symbolism and faith. The Gospel recounts Mary and Joseph bringing the infant Jesus to the temple, fulfilling the law of Moses. In this act, they reveal their profound faith and

trust in God, dedicating their Son—the very Light of the World—to the Father.

In the temple, we encounter Simeon and Anna, two figures of faith who waited patiently for the coming of the Messiah. 
