



Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,

At all the Masses last weekend Traci Peters, the chairperson for

the upcoming Crab Feed talked about the need for volunteers and we got a very positive response. Thank you to all who have or will sign up to help!

Our Church projects are active now. The handrails are installed and the step replacement has been started which may take 4 weeks. Thank you for your patience and cooperation during the project.

The readings of this weekend challenge us to avoid Job's pessimistic and desperate view of life as a chain of pain and sufferings and to accept life with hope and optimism as a precious gift from God, using it to do good for others and spending our time, talents and lives for others as Jesus did and as St. Paul did.

In the First Reading, Job complains of the tedium and futility of life and the miseries of human existence. But, when his eyes are opened by God, Job surrenders himself, his suffering, his work and everything he had and loses to God's greater wisdom.

The Second Reading reveals Paul to us as a true, dynamic follower of Jesus, moved as Jesus was by concern for the lost which led him to preach the Gospel without cost to the people, and to serve them as their slave with Jesus' love and fidelity.

Pointing out the spontaneous response of Peter's mother-in-law after she had been healed by Jesus, this weekend's Gospel teaches us that true disciple-ship means giving selfless, loving service to others.
