

## Clergy Corner



Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,

Today, as Jesus steps into the waters of the Jordan, He does something surprising: the sinless Son of God stands in line with sinners. He does not distance Himself from our weakness; instead, He enters fully into our human story. In that moment, the heavens open, the Spirit descends, and the Father's voice is heard: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

This feast reminds us of our own baptism. Before we achieved anything, before we proved ourselves worthy, God called us His beloved children. Our identity begins not with success or failure, but with love.

- **Live from your identity:** When you feel discouraged or pressured to prove yourself, remember: you are already loved by God.
- **Choose humility:** Like Jesus, be willing to stand with others, especially the overlooked or misunderstood.
- **Listen for God's voice:** Make time for quiet prayer. God still speaks words of love and guidance to open hearts.
- **Be a sign of God's pleasure:** Through kindness, honesty, and forgiveness, let others experience God's love through you.

As we begin a new year, the Gospel invites us to bring our everyday struggles—our families, work, health, and uncertainties—into God's presence. Our baptism assures us that God walks with us through every season.

- Renew your commitment to prayer, even if brief and simple.
- Carry your faith into ordinary moments.
- Be a source of encouragement in a world longing for hope.

May this feast renew our baptismal grace and help us walk as beloved sons and daughters, bringing light and hope to the world.
