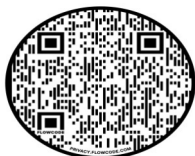

Clergy Corner



Dear Members of St. Mary Parish Family,

This Sunday brings together a beautiful harmony of themes—love, motherhood, mission, and faithful witness.

In the Gospel for the Sixth Sunday of Easter, Jesus tells His disciples: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.” This is not a command rooted in fear, but an invitation grounded in love. True love always expresses itself in action—through kindness, sacrifice, forgiveness, and fidelity to God’s will. Jesus also promises the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who remains with us, guiding and strengthening us to live this love in our daily lives.

As we celebrate Mother’s Day, we give thanks for the gift of mothers—those who have given us life, nurtured us, and reflected God’s tender love. Their quiet sacrifices, patience, and enduring care are living examples of the love Jesus speaks about. Today we honor not only biological mothers, but also all women who embody spiritual motherhood through compassion, guidance, and service. May God bless them abundantly and grant eternal rest to those who have gone before us.

We also commemorate Our Lady of Fatima, who appeared with a message of prayer, repentance, and peace. Mary, our Blessed Mother, always leads us closer to her Son. Her call at Fatima remains relevant: to pray the Rosary, to turn away from sin, and to trust in God’s mercy. In a world often marked by unrest and uncertainty, her message invites us to become instruments of peace rooted in prayer.

Additionally, we remember St. Matthias the Apostle, chosen to take the place of Judas among the Twelve. Though not one of the original apostles, Matthias reminds us that God calls each of us in our own time and way. Faithfulness, not prominence, is what matters. Like him, we are invited to witness to Christ in our lives—quietly but courageously.

Together, these celebrations form a powerful message: love must be lived, faith must be practiced, and every vocation—whether in family life, consecrated life, or daily witness—is a response to God’s call.

May this week be an opportunity for each of us to deepen our love for Christ, to honor those who have nurtured us, and to say “yes” more fully to God’s invitation in our lives. With prayers and blessings,
