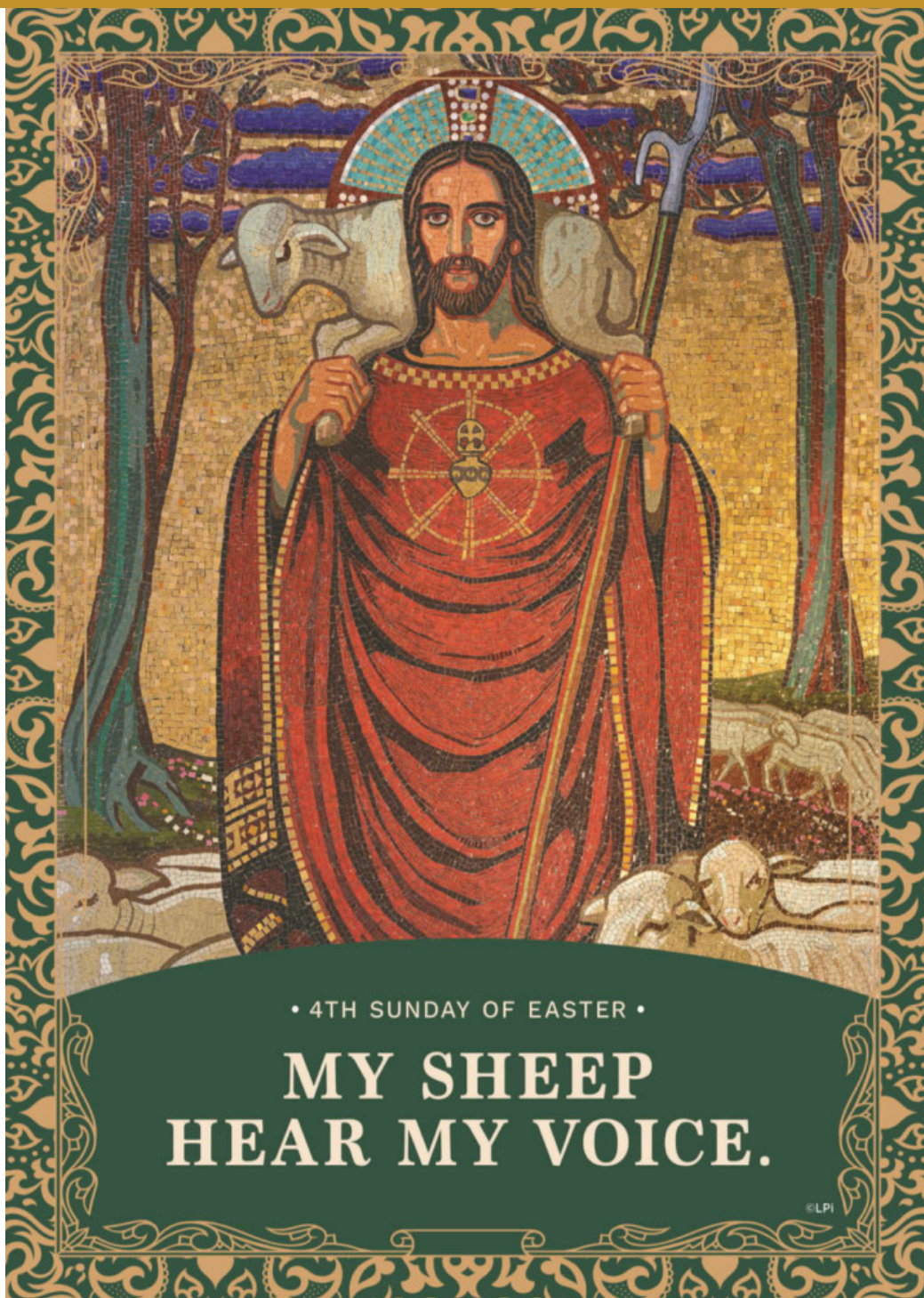

## Clergy Corner

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Today is Mother's Day! Let us remember all mothers with gratitude, and pray for God's blessings to be upon them. Happy Mother's Day!

This Sunday, we are invited to listen more closely to the voice of the Good Shepherd. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks tenderly of His relationship with us: "My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me." These simple yet powerful words remind us that being a Christian is not just about knowing about Jesus, but truly knowing Him—recognizing His voice, trusting His guidance, and following where He leads.

The First Reading from Acts shows Paul and Barnabas courageously proclaiming the Good News, even in the face of rejection. They model the courage we are called to live out as followers of the Shepherd—speaking truth and love, even when it's difficult.

In Revelation, we catch a glimpse of our destination: a multitude from every nation, rejoicing in God's presence. The Lamb who was slain becomes the Shepherd, leading His people to springs of life-giving water. It is both a promise and hope.

As we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, we also mark the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We are encouraged to pray for those discerning a call to priesthood, diaconate, religious life, or other forms of service in the Church. Let us also ask the Lord to help each of us discover and live out our unique vocation, always following His voice with faith and joy.

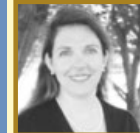

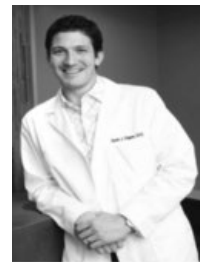
