# **Clergy Corner**

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Today, we come together to celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, a central mystery of our Christian faith that calls us to reflect on the nature of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This feast highlights the profound unity and perfect love within the Trinity, which serves as a model for our own

Help us to live in that love, united in our diversity, and reflecting Your divine light to the world. May our lives bear witness to the unity and love that is the hallmark of Your divine nature. Amen.
