St. Vincent de Paul Society Report to Parish

Dear Parishioners . Our SVdP conference ended it's fiscal year on September 30, 2025. During the year we visited the households of 125 neighbors in need - all of whom live in the parish boundaries of St. Mary and Sacred Heart. We served 405 adults and 350 children with \$46,222 in financial assistance and \$29,680 donated goods, primarily 742 bags of food. The financial assistance kept people in their homes with money for rent and utilities on. We also provided beds to those who were sleeping on the floor and clothing through our Thrift Store.

And all of this good work was done through volunteers. We only spent 2.6% of our budget on overhead and expenses.

Almost all of our budget came directly through your donations to the Annual Catholic Appeal, the Fifth Sunday Collection and food donations.

- In October, we were able to fill the Thrift Store truck with clothing, household items and furniture which is already being to use to help those in need.
- You have also been very generous with our blanket drive. For every home we visit this winter, we will deliver a new blanket blessed and inscribed as a donation from you.
- Look for a new event in April A Paper Shred day, just in time for your old tax paperwork.
- Times are tough and we see the need increasing.
