

This Sunday we are having our Parish Ministry Fair in Giovanni Hall. I am so happy to encourage each one of you to visit our fair and also encourage you to be part of at least one of the ministries of our parish. I thank all those who worked hard to make this day possible. May God

This Sunday's readings invite us to reflect on the power of gratitude and faith. In the Gospel (Luke 17:11-19), Jesus heals ten lepers, but only one—a Samaritan—returns to thank Him. This story is not only about healing but about recognizing God's grace and responding with a grateful heart. True faith leads to thanksgiving, and thanksgiving leads to deeper union with God.

This week, the Church also celebrates three great saints who model faith, courage, and gratitude in their lives:

- St. Teresa of Jesus (Avila), the great Carmelite reformer, who reminds us that prayer and trust in God can transform our lives.
- St. Ignatius of Antioch, an early bishop and martyr, whose fearless witness in the face of persecution teaches us how to live and die for Christ.
- St. Luke the Evangelist, the author of the Gospel we are reading this year, who presents Christ's mercy and compassion so vividly and calls us to be missionaries of the Good News.

As we meditate on these readings and feasts, let us ask for the grace to live our faith with gratitude and courage. Like the one leper who returned to give thanks, may our lives become a continual act of thanksgiving to God through prayer, service, and joyful witness to the Gospel.
