

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Greetings on World Mission Sunday — We Are All Missionaries.
Every year, World Mission Sunday reminds us that we are all part of a great story — the story of God's love being carried to the ends of the earth. Some go with their feet; others go with their prayers and their generosity.

When you pray for missionaries, when you give to the Mission Sunday collection, when you share your faith gently with others — you become part of God's mission.

Pope Francis reminds us: "Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus."

If you have met Christ — even once — then you are called to bring that encounter to someone else. Let us live out the missionary spirit in our daily lives:

- Spend five minutes each day praying for missionaries around the world.
- Offer a smile to someone who feels forgotten.
- Read a passage from Scripture and share it with your family.
- Visit a lonely neighbour or call someone who has been on your heart.
- Contribute to the World Mission Sunday collection with love.

Above all, **pray persistently**, like the widow in today's Gospel — trusting that your small acts of faith move mountains. Mission is not about doing great things for God; it is about letting God do great things through us.

When we pray without losing heart, love without measure, and serve without counting the cost, we become living missionaries of Christ's heart — right where we are.

Let our prayer this Sunday be: "Lord, make me Your missionary of love. Teach me to pray always and never lose heart. Let my words, my hands, and my life tell the world that You are love."

"The Church is missionary by nature," says St. John Paul II, "because the love of Christ cannot remain silent."
