

Clergy Corner

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



This Sunday's readings invite us to reflect on true humility before God. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. The Pharisee praises himself; the tax collector simply prays, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." Jesus reminds us that what

lifts us up before God is not pride in our goodness, but the humble recognition of our need for His mercy.

The first reading from Sirach affirms that God listens to the prayer of the humble and the poor, and the second reading from St. Paul expresses the confidence of one who has fought the good fight and kept the faith. The thread that ties these together is the awareness that all we have and are comes from God's grace.

This week we also celebrate the Feast of St. Simon and St. Jude, two apostles who quietly but faithfully carried the Gospel to distant lands. Though little is known of them, their steadfast witness reminds us that holiness often grows in hidden, faithful service. Their lives teach us that every disciple, however unknown, has a place in God's plan of salvation.

And as we prepare to celebrate All Saints Day, we remember that the call to holiness is for all—not just for a few extraordinary people. The saints were ordinary men and women who lived their faith with courage, love, and humility. Like the tax collector in the Gospel, they knew their need for God's mercy and allowed His grace to transform them.

May this week inspire us to pray with humble hearts, to serve with quiet faithfulness like St. Simon and St. Jude, and to walk the path of holiness with joy. The saints remind us that sanctity is not about perfection, but about perseverance in love.
