



Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.

# **Clergy Corner**

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



This week (9/5) we celebrate the Feast of St. Teresa of Calcutta. She was born August 26, 1910 in Skopje, North Macedonia. In 1950 she founded the Missionaries of Charity that had over 4,500 sisters active in some 133 countries as of 2012. Her congregation oversees homes for

those who are dying of various diseases. It also runs soup kitchens, dispensaries, mobile clinics, children's and family counseling programs well as orphanages and schools. She died on September 5th, 1997, and was canonized in 2016 by Pope Francis. Happy Feast to all!

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus addresses the Pharisees and Scribes who are overly concerned with external observances of the law while neglecting the more important matters of the heart. He challenges them, and us, to examine our inner lives and not just our outward actions. Jesus emphasizes that what defiles a person is not what enters from the outside, but what comes from within. This powerful reminder calls us to reflect on the state of our hearts. Are we more concerned with appearances and traditions than with genuine love and compassion? Do our words and actions truly reflect the love of Christ?

As we navigate through life, it's easy to get caught up in routines, rituals and appearances. But this Sunday's Gospel challenges us to go deeper, to focus on what truly matters- our relationship with God and with one another. Let us strive to cultivate a heart that is pure, loving, and aligned with God's will.

May this week be an opportunity for us all to reflect on the intentions behind our actions, to purify our hearts, and to seek God's guidance in living out our faith with sincerity and love.

Let us pray for the grace to be people whose hearts are centered on Christ, so that our lives may be a true reflection of His love in the world.


