Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Greetings to each one of you. As we can see, our landscaping project is almost finished and it looks pretty good. Let us gratefully remember Nick Clifford who sacrificed a lot of his time, and also our Parish Maintenance Committee members for this accomplishment.

Our St. Joseph Garden fence and Church front steps replacement projects will start soon.

Tomorrow is the anniversary of the tragic events of September 11th. Let us remember all the fire-fighters, police officers and emergency medical technicians who serve the local community.

This Thursday, September 14th, we celebrate the Feast of The Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This day commemorates the discovery of the Lord's cross by the empress, St. Helena in 320.

This Friday, September 15th, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. By the 14th century, the sorrows of Mary numbered seven: the presentation of Jesus in the Temple, the flight into Egypt, Jesus being lost in Jerusalem: the meeting of Mary and Jesus on the way to calvary: the crucifixion: the taking down of Jesus' body from the cross: and his burial. Let us ask for the intercession of Our Blessed Virgin Mary.

The common theme of this Sunday's readings is God's command concerning our spiritual responsibility and individual accountability for others in our families, parishes, and community. This accountability arises from our identity as God's children. As brothers and sisters in Christ, then, we become each other's "keepers," and take on a painful, triple responsibility. We must lovingly and prudently correct each other when we err, forgive those who offend us, and ask forgiveness from those we have offended.


