





Clergy Corner

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



First off, I would like to congratulate Fr. George Mathai who officially received his appointment letter as the part-time Parochial Vicar of St. Mary Parish and part-time Chaplain of St. Francis High School from Bishop Soto. Wish you all the best Fr. Mathai!

I also gratefully remember Tim Frame, our Parish Finance Council Chair, who beautifully presented the financial status of our parish last weekend. I think it was eye opening for all of us where we are in the matter of our finances. I also thank each one of you for your great contributions and support to our parish, and request that you encourage anyone you know who hasn't returned after the pandemic to come home to St. Mary's.

Our readings for this 24th Sunday concern forgiving those who wrong us and being reconciled with them. All three readings remind us of the path to forgiveness, mercy, and reconciliation and challenge us to walk this, the only Way of Life. In the First Reading, Sirach, reminds his listeners that if they don't forgive and show mercy, they can't expect to receive mercy from God in return. In the second reading, Paul reminds us that we have to forgive others because we belong to Christ who, by his own example in forgiving those who killed Him, taught us how we must forgive. Since we humans are related to each other as brothers and sisters of Jesus, we are in the Family of God, so hatred and bitterness toward anyone should have no place in our hearts. In today's Gospel, through the parable of the two debtors, Jesus teaches us that there should be no limit to our forgiveness and no conditions attached to our reconciliation. We represent the greater debtor in the parable because we commit sins every day and need God's forgiveness every day, but we must forgive in order to be forgiven.
