Clergy Corner

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,



Life is short, and time is precious. Each day we make countless choices—big and small—that shape not only our future on earth but also our eternal destiny. What we do with the resources God entrusts to us-our time, talents, relationships, wealth—reveals who we truly serve:

God or ourselves.

The Gospel this Sunday gives us one of Jesus' most surprising parables—the story of the dishonest steward. At first glance, it may shock us. How could Jesus possibly use a dishonest man as an example? Yet, Jesus does not praise the steward's dishonesty; He praises his foresight, creativity, and determination. The steward realized he had only a little time left, and he acted decisively for his future. Jesus invites us to show that same determination—but not for temporary wealth or comfort, rather for the kingdom of God.

The Gospel challenges us in three ways:

- 1. Be Wise with What God Gives You The steward acted quickly when he realized time was running out. Our time on earth is also short. How often do we postpone prayer, forgiveness, or generosity, thinking there will always be tomorrow? Jesus reminds us: now is the time to act.
- 2. **Serve God, Not Money** Money itself is not evil-it can do great good-but when it becomes our master, it enslaves us. We live in a world that constantly tells us happiness comes from wealth, possessions, and status. But Jesus says, "What does it profit a man to gain the whole world and lose his soul?"
- 3. Use Earthly Resources for Eternal Treasures Every act of kindness, every generous gift, every sacrifice for others—these are investments in heaven. As the story of the cashier who paid for the elderly man's groceries reminds us, when we use money with love, it gains eternal meaning.

Let us pray this week for the courage to serve God alone and to use our earthly blessings to build eternal treasures.
