St. Mary Parish School Strategic Plan Update: The Journey Continues



Thank you to everyone who has participated in our Strategic Planning process and shared your hopes, experiences, and ideas for St. Mary Parish School via the Parish/School Partnership Survey and School Domain no. 1 (Mission and Catholic Identity) survey. Your participation is helping us make room for thoughtful conversation about the future of our shared community.

This month, we will review and analyze feedback from the two surveys. We will also conduct our first Strategic Plan Roundtable on Tuesday, September 8, when representatives from across our school and parish will gather for prayer, reflection, and conversation regarding Domain no. 1.

Our first roundtable falls on the **Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. As we celebrate St. Mary's birth and the beginning of her life within God's plan, we are reminded that God is always at work in new beginnings. We ask for St. Mary's intercession as we begin this next chapter for St. Mary Parish School.

The listening process will continue in the months ahead. In October, we will explore Domain no. 2 (Governance & Leadership). That survey will open in October, and our school community is invited to reflect on how leadership serves our mission, how decisions are made, and how we work together to support our children and school community.

Dear Members of St. Mary's Parish Family,

This weekend, as we celebrate the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are reminded that Christian discipleship is not something we practice alone. In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that we have a responsibility toward one another: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone." Jesus calls us to be a community that cares enough to speak the truth with love, seek reconciliation, and help one another remain faithful.

As we celebrate Labor Day, we also give thanks for the gift and dignity of human work. 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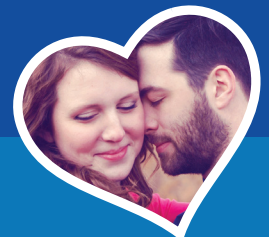
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
